BLACK COHOSH ADULTERATION PRODUCT LIST

FOR: BLACK COHOSH (*Cimicifuga Racemosa*)

- NOTE: 1)** To date, in large part (if not exclusively) the adulterated "Black Cohosh" extracts are produced in China from specie(s) other than *C. racemosa*. It is also interesting to note that the plant itself, Black Cohosh (*C. racemosa*) is not present in China. The incentive behind this adulteration is economic. Several plant from China have been identified as an economic adulterant. This is the botanical ***Cimicifuga foetida***, though likely there are also other closely related plants that are used as well.
- 2)** Detection of the chemical **Cimifugin**:
The compound Cimifugin is present in many of the adulterated "Black Cohosh" products. Cimifugin naturally occurs in one or more of the plants that are used presently as economic adulterants for "Black Cohosh." It is documented that Cimifugin is not present in authentic Black Cohosh species (*C. racemosa*). Therefore, **detection of Cimifugin proves a product is NOT Black Cohosh**. The **Australian TGA** (equivalent to the U.S. FDA) has studied this matter closely, and now **requires non-detection for Cimifugin** in TGA registration for Black Cohosh.
