Dr. Ryan Dellinger is an accomplished scientist with more than 18 years of experience in basic and translational scientific research. He possesses a broad scientific knowledge base in the fields of molecular biology, cell biology, pharmacology and cancer prevention.

As an advisor to Spherix Consulting, Dr. Dellinger will provide ongoing strategic and scientific guidance to our clients including assistance with clinical trial placement and design. As a Director at ChromaDex, Dr. Dellinger is integrally involved in the development of current products, including coordination of clinical studies with ChromaDex's partners.

Prior to joining ChromaDex, Dr. Dellinger was an Assistant Project Scientist at the University of California, Irvine, where he was involved in several pre-clinical and clinical studies investigating skin cancer. In one study he demonstrated that pterostilbene can prevent UV-B mediated skin damage (in mice).

Dr. Dellinger previously served as a postdoctoral researcher in the Pharmacology Department at Penn State University Medical Center, where he where he spent four years investigating the mechanism of activity of Phase II metabolic enzymes and their role in cancer risk, treatment and prevention. He also supervised several graduate students and lectured for graduate classes (PHARM 503 and PHARM 550). Prior to Penn State, Dr. Dellinger was a Research Scientist at NewBiotics, Inc and was involved in the development of novel chemotherapeutic agents for various cancers.
